ROAD CLOSURE PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

Road closures are only permitted when approved by Highway authorities on highways under their respective jurisdiction.

Approval of a Temporary Road Closure Permit shall only be granted under conditions that will insure reasonable safety for all event participants, spectators and highway users and provide a safe alternative route for traffic.

Requirements for the granting of the permit are as follows:

The sponsoring agency or group shall:

- 1. Present a traffic control plan and detour map-meeting requirement outlined in the "Uniform Manual of Traffic Control Devices"
- 2. Furnish all signs, barricades and personnel described in the traffic control plan.
- 3. Notify the McLean County Sheriff, in writing, at least seven (7) days in advance of the event.

- 4. Provide the McLean County Highway Department with a Certificate of Insurance and Additional Insured Endorsement showing that the sponsor has General Liability Insurance or Special Event Insurance in the minimum amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) and that said policy names McLean County, its Boards, Officers, and Employees as Additional Insured. Assume all risks and liabilities in connection with the event and shall indemnify and hold harmless McLean County, its Boards, Officers, and Employees for any liability and third party liability arising from said event.
- 5. Provide the McLean County Highway Department with a copy of any participant use agreement or liability form, which outlines requirements of acceptance and participation in said event. Such agreement shall have a hold harmless provision referring to McLean County, its Boards, Officers and employees and recognition that the participants knowingly and willingly accept the risks inherent in the event.
- 6. Contact and secure permission from all road districts and municipalities as may be involved with the detour.
- 7. Submit a plan for additional services that may be needed to insure the public health safety and welfare such as but not limited to security, street cleaning and garbage pickup.






