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Law Library Fund

An audit of the McLean County Law Library Fund has been completed by the County Auditor's Office as mandated by the Illinois Complied Statues, Chapter 55, Act 5, Section 5-39001.

Findings

- An amendment to an amendment to the resolution establishing a Law Library fee was passed by the McLean County Board on August 22, 2006. It states that the \$10.00 filing fee will be permanent on all civil case filings.
- The fees for adoptions have been capped at \$65.00. The Law Library Fund fee on adoptions is \$6.00.
- Fees collected are banked daily and then transferred monthly to the treasurer.
- A copy of the semi-annual report filed with the McLean County Clerk's Office was obtained and is in balance through June 30, 2006.
- All expenses for this fund must be approved by the Chief Judge of the Circuit Court.
- All expenditures were tested and all necessary approvals obtained.
- A new, coin operated copy machine was purchased in June, 2006. There is a fee of ten cents per copy. Fees for the Law Library Fund are also paid by the Bloomington Bar Association, the McLean County Public Defender's Office, the McLean County State's Attorney's Office, and the McLean County Court Services Office.

The scope of this examination consisted of reviewing financial transactions and financial documents related to the Law Library Fund and conducting an interview with Phyllis Nelson, Chief Deputy Circuit Clerk. After reviewing the information gathered, we noted nothing that would indicate the McLean County Law Library Fund is not in compliance with statutory requirements regarding the fund account.

Management Interview Date: 11/28/2006

Background:

- The Safe Havens: Supervised Visitation and Safe Exchange Grant Program is a Federal grant through the U.S. Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women and McLean County. McLean County is the pass through agent to the Family Visitation Center of McLean County.
- This grant was originally awarded in November 2002. Funds became available in February 2003, and the Family Visitation Center (FVC) opened on a full time basis March 1, 2003.
- In October 2004, the FVC received the Safe Havens grant to expand services to the entire Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Illinois. This expansion included the five contiguous rural counties of Piatt, DeWitt, Ford, Woodford, and Livingston.

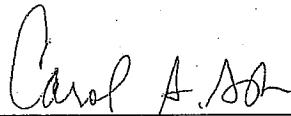
Findings:

- In compliance with the grant agreement, the Family Visitation Center provides adequate safety measures including: a camera monitoring system that was updated in 2005, wall mounted panic buttons, wireless panic buttons, parking on separate sides of the building to avoid contact between conflicting individuals, and a hired safety monitor to review case files. Teresa Kelly, Director of the program, stated that even though the security system was recently updated, that type of technology changes so rapidly that they are going to be recommending a newer system with less lag time. (The current system has a four second lag time).
- The Family Visitation Center retains a "no turn-away" policy regarding its case selection methods. They provide supervised visitation and safe exchange for children in McLean County, and the surrounding rural counties, in situations involving domestic violence, child abuse, sexual assault, or stalking. The Family Visitation Center may decline its services in the event the individuals seeking its services represent a threat to the staff or the children's safety.
- As reported in the semi-annual progress report, the number of people trained represents both the number of individuals who attend the Family Visitation Center's presentations in the community and training events hosted by the Family Visitation Center. The FVC presents between four and six training sessions a year and hosts a large scale event one or two times a year. The FVC keeps a record of the individuals who attend their hosted training sessions, but does not keep a record of the individuals serviced at a presentation to the community.
- A financial audit of the Family Visitation Center consisted of obtaining the quarterly reports for 2006, requesting documentation showing receipt of grant funds and testing of expenses for one grant quarter.
- Mr. Lindberg, McLean County Assistant Administrator, was also interviewed for clarification on payment to the FVC for the pass through monies. He stated that the Administrator's office receives a letter from Teresa Kelly at the FVC stating that they have filed their quarterly report with the Department of Justice. Mr.

Lindberg then instructs the Assistant Treasurer, Cathy Dreyer, to draw down the money at the Department of Justice. Mrs. Dreyer calls the Department of Justice using the required PAPRS system. Two days later, she checks the county's bank account to verify the money has been received. She then wires the money to the Family Visitation Center's bank account for reimbursement.

- An interview with Teresa Kelly and Lesley Frey from the Advisory Board was also conducted. They stated that this year they were fearful that they would not receive the Safe Havens grant. The Family Visitation Center in McLean County is the only facility in Illinois to receive the current year grant. She also stated that she would be surprised if they received the funding after this grant term.

After reviewing the semi-annual progress reports and quarterly financial reports, auditing a quarter's transactions, and interviewing management regarding specific compliance requirements, it is my opinion that the Family Visitation Center is operating in compliance with the Safe Havens: Supervised Visitation and Safe Exchange Grant Program (CFDA: 16.527) agreement between the United States Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women and McLean County.

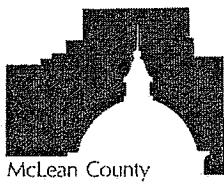
Re: Signage Content Associated with Section 39-5 of the County Smoking Restriction Ordinance.

At its December meeting, I was requested by committee member David Selzer to appear before the committee to discuss recommended language for signs required under Section 39-5 of the recently enacted ordinance restricting smoking in public places within unincorporated areas of McLean County. I forwarded suggested language to County Administrator John Zeunik for his review. Mr. Zeunik, in turn, reviewed the information with Civil Assistant State's Attorney Eric Ruud to determine whether the specific content that I recommended would require an amendment to the ordinance.

It is Mr. Ruud's opinion that sections 39-5 and 39-11 provide sufficient latitude to craft specific language for the signs without necessitating an amendment to the ordinance. The specific language I recommended is as follows:

"Smoking Permitted: Environmental tobacco smoke has been classified by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency as a Category A carcinogen and poses a serious health risk. Those with heart disease, respiratory disease, infants or pregnant women should not enter the premises."

Although secondhand smoke poses a danger to the public in general, the categories identified in the proposed language are at heightened risk. As a matter of public education and to provide a public health advisory, the specific language is recommended. This item is presented for informational purposes.

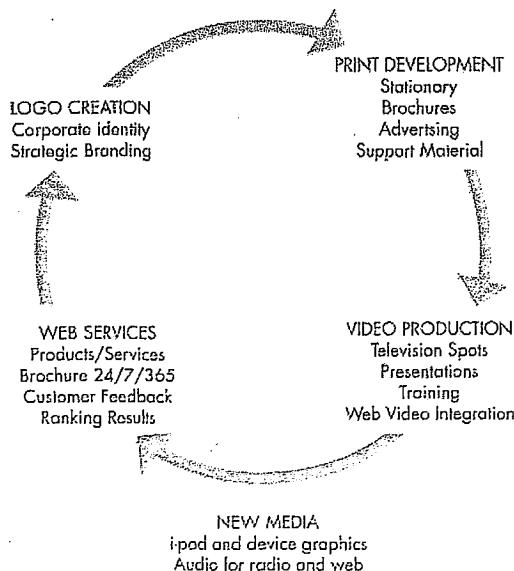

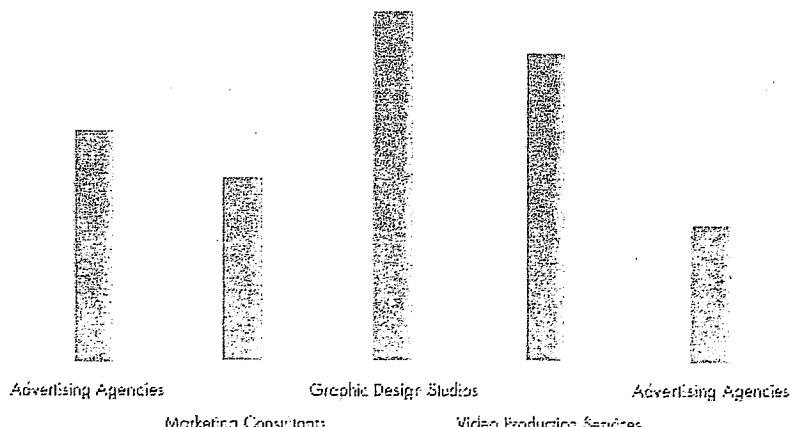

Introduction

Enclosed please find a request for funding from the McLean County Revolving Loan Fund for \$30,000. Enclosed you will find the following required items:

1. A completed application from the applicant.
2. A business plan and background information from the applicant.

Proposal

The applicant, Brad Barth, President of Trace Design has asked the County for \$30,000 from the Revolving Loan fund for the expansion of his current business. Trace has had offices in Downtown Bloomington over the past eight of nine years. Over the past year the company has operated from a home office. A new office and expansion of the business will occur at 114 North Street in Uptown Normal. This location is on the second floor above the current Micheleo's Restaurant, adjacent to the new Medici's Restaurant currently under construction and across from the new Coffee Hound (which the County helped fund). The owners of the building have received a façade improvement grant from the Town of Normal which will restore the building's historic structure and blend with other improvements in the uptown area.

The applicant is seeking to add two new employees and greatly expand their offerings. This includes delving into new media, and the congruence of print, film, video and internet technologies. In a new economy, and in an economy that strives to meet the needs of a younger generation, the jobs being created by Trace design helps fulfill that mission. Trace hopes to grow their new business technology and business models as they are introduced.

The applicant meets the mission of the loan program. The mission of the loan fund is to:

- Assist short term economic development by creating and retaining jobs.
- Encourage involvement of area financial institutions.

- Assist long term economic development by increasing the tax base and helping to expand the economy.
- Insure financial security of the Fund through appropriate use.

In addition, the applicant meets the key criteria of the loan program in that they are creating or retaining at least one full-time equivalent job for every \$15,000 being loaned or requested. In the request they are creating 2 full-time equivalent positions which would make them eligible for \$30,000. The loan meets the criteria of benefiting 51% of low to moderate income positions. All of the positions except, the owners meet this criterion. Financial need is exhibited through the "fill the gap" criteria of the project as evidenced by the letter from the primary bank lender.

Credit Committee Summary

Under new procedures, the loan application is reviewed by a credit committee. This committee is made up of

The RLF Credit Committee convened on Thursday, December 21 at 10:00 at the McLean County Government Building, room 404. The committee reviewed the application, and measured it against the criteria under which RLF Loans are made. The committee made the following findings:

1. The applicant has sufficient collateral to secure the loan of \$30,000 from the County.
2. The applicant is creating two new full time equivalent jobs required under the loan program for the amount borrowed.
3. The applicant meets the requirement of benefiting 50% of low-to moderate income individuals.
4. The applicant has support from their Bank and the Bank has indicated that "but-for" the RLF loan, the project could not go forward.

Recommendation

The applicant has all the tools necessary to succeed with this project. Trace Design has been business over nine years and has a strong client list. Trace has been very successful

as a "one-man" shop but at this point would like to expand. This new project would represent new growth for the business.

The applicant has a strong record with their current banker, in paying down current loans and obligations. Bank of Illinois is confident in the client and their ability to perform. Sales estimates are conservative, and the owner is very involved in all aspects of the business. Trace design has received national attention for its work, garnering a national award for a client this past year.

The credit committee would recommend approval of this loan and ask for County Board approval for these reasons. The project will be a great addition to the business landscape of Uptown Normal, provide some jobs, and generate tax revenue. The approval should be subject to

1. Bank approval of the applicant's loan, which is pending,
2. A personal guarantee by the applicant.
3. Updated cash flow projections for the file.

The recommended interest and term for the loan is five years at 5.2% which is slightly above the current deposit rate of the fund the County Treasurer currently receives at the time of approval of this application.

Disclosure: Trace design has been doing all the graphic design work of the EDC over the past two years. We pay Trace design market rate for work performed. Trace Design has also invested in the EDC Navigating a New Direction campaign which recently finished its work (2/21/06).
