

## **Minutes of the Liquor Control Commission**

The Liquor Control Commission of the McLean County Board met on Monday, June 23, 2003, at 9:00 a.m. in Room 700, Law and Justice Center, 104 West Front Street, Bloomington, Illinois.

Mr. Eric Ruud, First Assistant State's Attorney, presented the annual liquor license renewals for McLean County. He stated that all of the current licensees had submitted applications for renewal, that he had reviewed all license renewal applications and found them to be in order.

Motion by Hoselton/Bostic to approve all submitted applications for the renewal of McLean County Liquor Licenses for the year 2003.  
Motion carried.

Ms. Bostic asked if there had been any police stings at any of the County taverns. Mr. Ruud replied that there had been some Illinois State Police undercover operations, but that they had involved liquor establishments in local towns and villages. However, no County liquor licensees were cited for violations.
